Brian Kremer, Corporation Counsel, "Does not go any farther than the Mayor. Grievances are filed and the arbitration process is followed."

Council Member Smith, "Is there a process to follow with all of the complaints? Even from citizens? Can Commissioner of Public Works be put on notice?"


